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Cutting Directions



Fabric #1 Tan Dots

- 2 inner borders 1 1/2" x 51 1/2"
- 2 inner borders 1 1/2" x 53 1/2"
- 4 squares 13" x 13" for HST Cut in half on the diagonal for side settings NOTE -if you starch your fabric first, the bias won't stretch on you.
- 2 squares 9 1/2" x 9 1/2" Cut in half on the diagonal for the corner triangles



Camping Prints For Center of the 4 blocks

- 4 square 8 1/2" x 8 1/2"

Mix of Camping Prints & other Prints for outer border

- A mix of 44 rectangles 4 1/2" x 5 1/2"
- 4 squares 4 1/2" x 4 1/2"

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Fabric #3 Gray Dots

- 2 inner borders 1 1/2" x 55 1/2"
- 2 inner borders 1 1/2" x 53 1/2"



Fabric #7 Light Green
- 16 squares 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"



Fabric #9 light blue - 16 strips 2 1/2" x 8 1/2"





Camping Print Block Directions


1) Following the diagram, use the 2 1/2" light green squares and 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" light blue Strips. Sew a green square to both ends of a strip.

Make 8 units

Measures 2 1/2" x 12 1/2"




2) Sew the Camping print blocks following the diagram using the 8 1/2" x 8 1/2" square of camping fabric. The units from above and the remaining 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" light blue strips



3) Sew the borders using the following the diagram using the 4 1/2" x 5 1/2" rectangles Sew all rectangles to each other

Make 4 borders

Measures 4 1/2" x 55 1/2"



The layout




Following the diagram using the Tan Dot setting squares.
 Sew the quilt center in rows once you have all the blocks.
 It's fun to start sewing the rows now and add as new blocks come in through October 2018

The setting triangles are slightly over sized.

Once you have this top trim square to 51 1/2" x 51 1/2"

Be sure to leave a 1/4" seam allowance around it.





5) Following the diagram using the Tan Dot first inner border, the Gray dot second inner borders, 4 1/2" squares and the mixed fabric outer borders to assemble the quilt.

Final quilt is 65 1/2" x 65 1/2"


