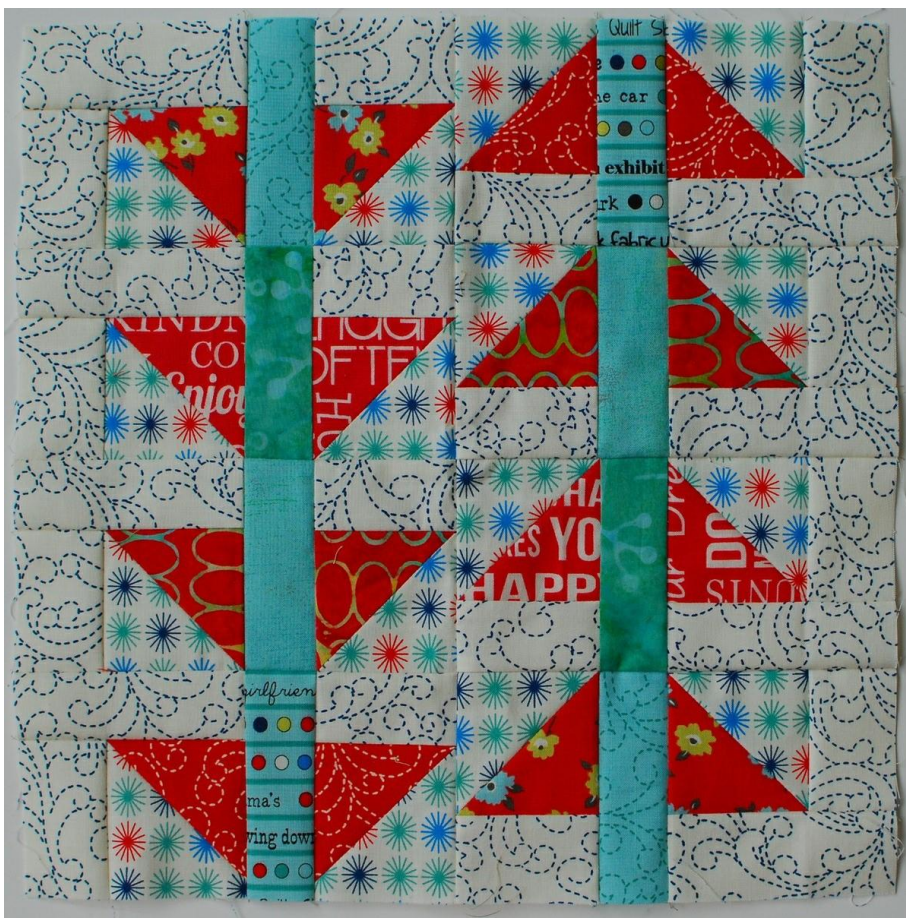

Block 9

Cutting Directions



Fabric #1 Cream/beige/white prints Cut Print 1

- 8 squares 3 " x 3" for HST

Print 2

- 8 rectangles 1 1/2" x 3 1/2"
- 16 rectangles 1 1/2" x 2 1/2"

Fabric #2 Red Prints Cut Print 1

- 2 squares 3 " x 3" for HST



Print 2

- 2 squares 3 " x 3" for HST

Print 3

- 2 squares 3 " x 3" for HST

Print 4

- 2 squares 3 " x 3" for HST



Fabric #3 Aqua Prints Cut Print 1

- 2 rectangles 1 1/2" x 3 1/2"

Print 2

- 2 rectangles 1 1/2" x 3 1/2"

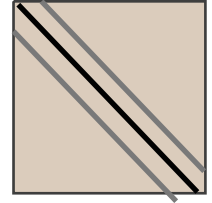
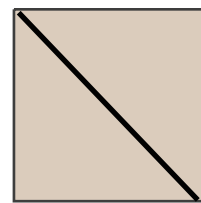
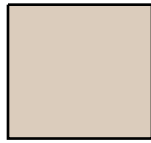

Half Square Triangles Tutorial

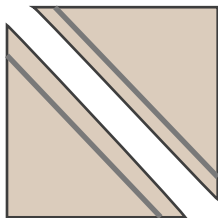


Step 1 - Make HST

Using the red and cream 3" squares,

Make 16 Half Square Triangle

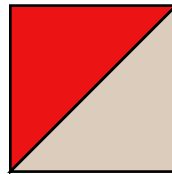
Step 2
(HST) units



Step 3

- Layer the dark and light square
- Draw a diagonal line on the back of all the light squares
- Sew a 1/4" seam on both sides of the drawn line
- Cut on the drawn line for 2 HST

Step 4



Seam.

Trim squares to 2.5" x 2.5" using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the

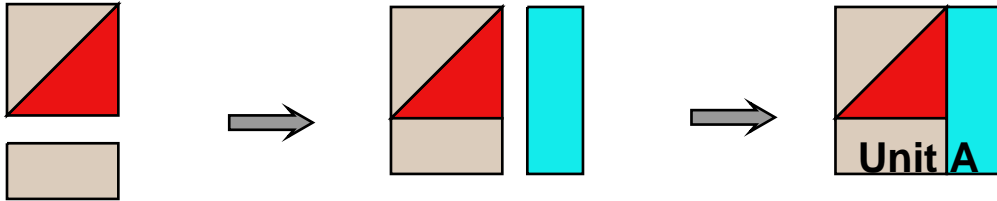

Step 2 Directions

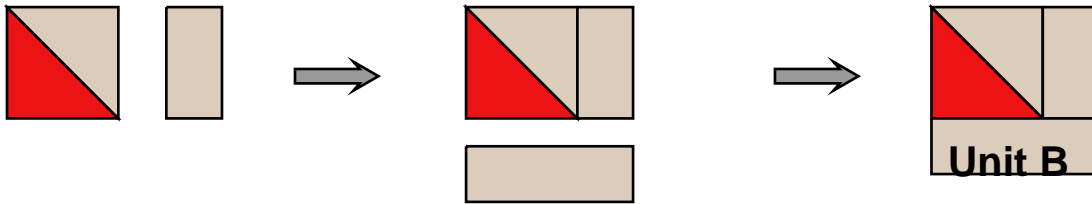
- 1) Following the Diagram, sew a HST and a small rectangle together. Keep the HST Pointing the correct way.
- 2) Sew the Aqua rectangle to the right side.

Make 8. Measure 3.5" x 3.5"



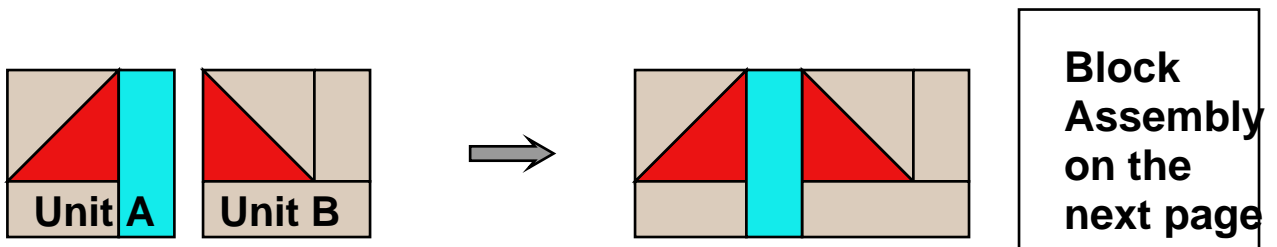
Step 3 Directions

- 1) Following the Diagram, sew a HST and a small rectangle together. Keep the HST Pointing the correct way.
- 2) Sew the long cream rectangle to the bottom. Make 8.
- 3) Measure 3.5" x 3.5"



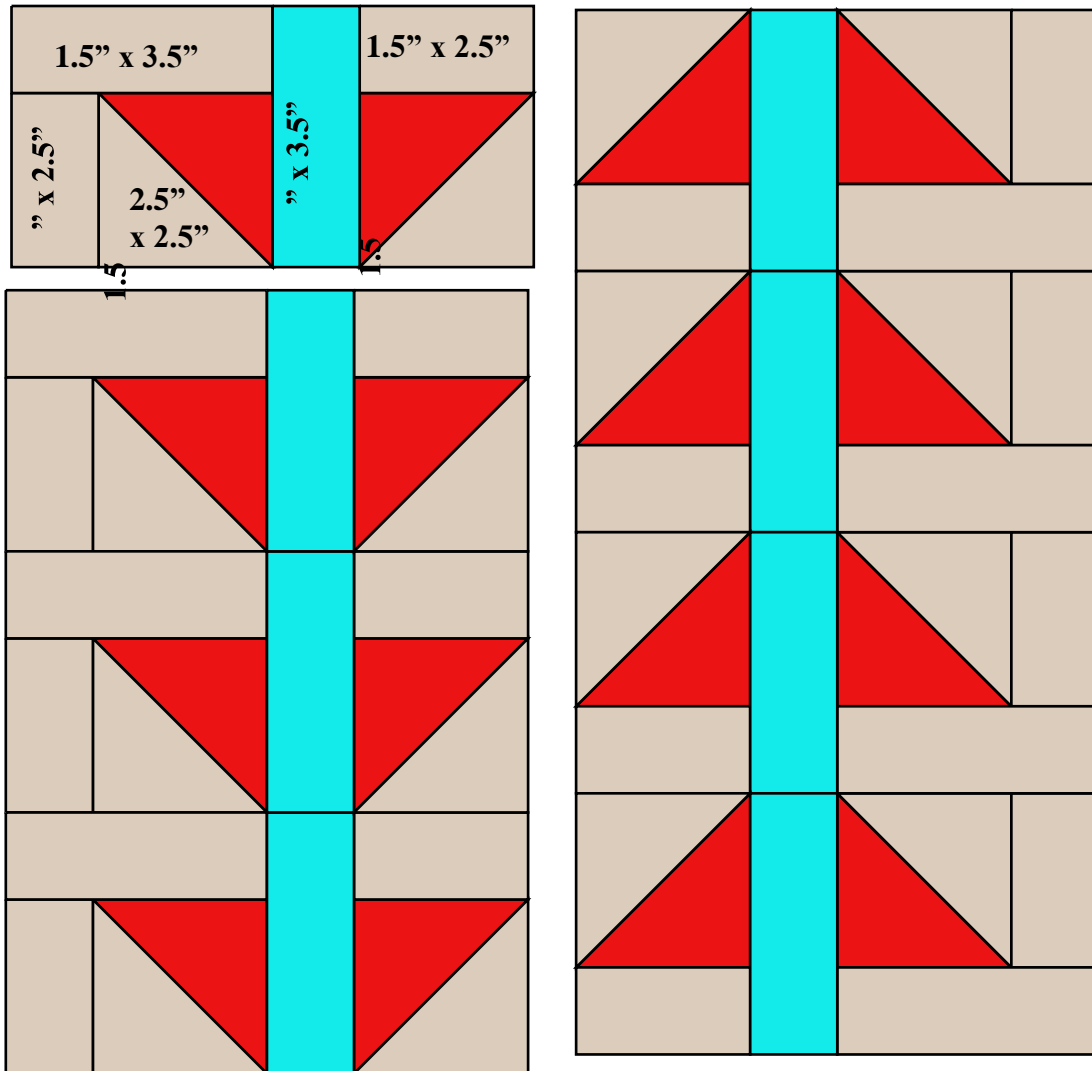
Step 4 Directions

- 1) Following the diagram sew Unit A to Unit B - NOTE the direction of the HSTs Make 8. Measure 3.5" x 6.5"



Unit size Assembly Diagram

Trim Block to 12.5" x 12.5"



Finished Size 12" in the quilt
