fresh and new ideas to be implemented. We encourage you to give serious thought about volunteering for one of these roles.

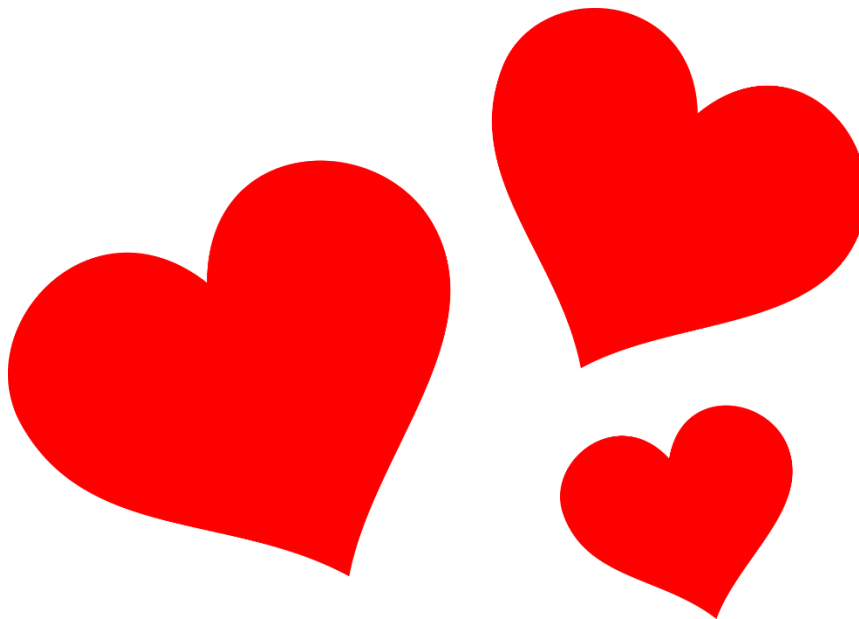

February Theme 'Everything Scrappy' - placemats, coasters, bags, lap quilts, baby bibs - make your fabric scrappy and have fun!

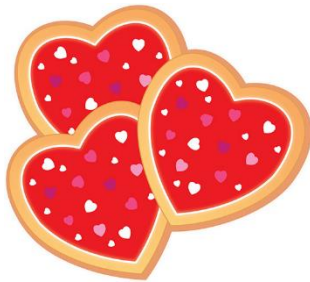
- Thank you everyone for your donation of bags. It looks like we have gathered enough for the show.
